

following list is considered as those days for which holiday rates of wages for work performed apply: New Year's Day, Memorial/Decoration Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day. Generally, any other days which fall on a Sunday is celebrated on the following Monday. This then makes work performed on that Monday payable at the appropriate overtime rate for holiday pay. Common practice in a given local may alter certain days of celebration such as the date of Thanksgiving for Veterans Day. If in doubt, please check with IDOL.

CLASSIFICATION OF CLASSES

TRUCK DRIVER - BUILDING, HEAVY AND HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION

- Class 1. Drivers on 2 axle trucks hauling less than 9 ton. Air compressor and welding machines and brooms, including those powered by separate units, truck driver helpers, warehousemen, mechanic helpers, greasers and tiremen, pickup trucks when hauling materials, to and from and on-the-job site, and fork lifts up to 6,000 lb. capacity.
- Class 2. Two or three axle trucks hauling more than 9 ton but hauling less than 16 ton. A-frame winch trucks, hydrolift trucks, or combination units when used for transportation purposes. Fork lifts over 6,000 lb. capacity, winch trucks, four axle combination units, and other equipment.
- Class 3. Two, three or four axle trucks hauling 16 ton or more. Drivers on water pulls, mechanics and working foremen, and dispatchers on four axle or more combination units.
- Class 4. Low Boy and Oil Distributors.

OPERATING ENGINEERS - BUILDING, HEAVY AND HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION

- Class 1. Asphalt Screed Man; Aspco Concrete Spreaders; Asphalt Pavers; Asphalt Plant Engineer; Asphalt Rollers on Bituminous Concrete Plants; Backfillers, Crane Type; Backhoes, Barber Green Loaders; Bulldozers; Cableways; Cherry Pickers; Clam Shells; C.M.I. & G. -autograde formless paver, autograde placer & finisher; Concrete Breakers; Concrete Plant Operators; Concrete Pumps; Cranes; Derrick Boats; Dewatering Systems; Draglines; Earth Auger or Boring Machines; Elevating Graders; Engineers on Dredges; Gravel Processors; Head Equipment Greaser; High Lifts or Fork Lifts; Hoists with two or more drums or two or more load lines; Locomotive Engines; Motor Graders or Auto Patrols; Operators or Leverman on Dredges; Operators, Power Boat; Operators, Pug Mill (Asphalt Plants); Overhead Cranes; Paving Mixers; Piledrivers; Pipe Wrapping and Painting Machines; Pushdozers, or Push Cats; Rock Crushers; Rollers or Similar Machines; Scoops, Skimmer, two cu. yd. capacity and under; Sheep-Foot Roller (Self-Propelled); Shovels; Skimmer Hoists; Hole Drilling Machines; Tower Cranes; Tower Machines; Tower Mixers; Track Type End Loaders; Track Type Fork Lifts or High Lifts; Tractors and Tampers; Tractors, Sideboom; Trenching or Ditching Machine; Tunnelluggers; Vermeer Type Saws; Wheel Type End Loaders; Winches All or Tournapull.
- Class 2. Air compressors (six to eight); Asphalt Boosters and Heaters; Asphalt Distributors, Asphalt Plant Fireman, Oiler on Two Drums when used in Tandem; Boom or Winch Trucks; Building Elevators; Bull Floats or Flexplanes; Concrete Finishing Machine; Concrete Pumps; Self-Propelled; Concrete Spreading Machines; Gravel or Stone Spreader, Power Operated; Hoist, Automatic; Hoist with One Drum and One Drum; Mud Jacks; Post Hole Digger, Mechanical; Road or Street Sweeper, Self-Propelled; Seaman Tiller; Straw Machine; Vibratory Compaction Machines; Drill Machines; Scissors Hoist.
- Class 3. Air Compressors, (one to five); Air Compressors, Track or Self-Propelled; Bulk Cement Batching Plants; Conveyors; Concrete Batching Plant, Paver, or Tower); Firemen; Generators; Greasers; Helper on Single Paving Mixer; Light Plants; Mechanic Helpers; Mechanics; Oilers; Power Form Graders; Power Sub-Graders; Tractors without power attachments regardless of size or type; Truck Crane Operator; Vibratory Hammer (power source); Water Pumps; Welding Machines (one/300 Amp. or over); Welding Machines, (one to five).

Other Classifications of Work:

If definitions of classifications not otherwise set out, the Department generally has on file such definitions which are available. If no such definition on file, the Bureau of Labor Statistics SIC list will be used. If a task to be performed is not subject to the classifications of pay set out, the Department will upon being contacted state which neighboring county has such a classification. If no such rate, such rate being deemed to exist by reference in this document. Further, if no such neighboring county rate applicable, the Department shall undertake a special determination, such special determination being then deemed to have existed under the same circumstances. If a project requires these, or any classification not listed, please contact IDOL at 618/993-7271 for wage rate determinations.

LANDSCAPING

Landscaping work falls under the existing classifications for laborer, operating engineer and truck driver. The work performed by landscape laborer and landscape laborer is covered by the existing classification of laborer. The work performed by landscape operators (regardless of equipment used or its size) is covered by the classifications of operating engineer. The work performed by landscape truck driver (regardless of size of truck driven) is covered by the classifications of truck driver.
