

MINUTES OF BOARD MEETING
LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS, DECATUR, ILLINOIS
APRIL 7. 1960

The meeting was called to order at 1 p.m. in the A of C room with Mrs. Neal Doubleday, President, presiding. Present were Mrs. Ater, Peterson, Smith, Mills, Volentine, Mauterer, Reeder, Dahlmann, Hein, Kessinger, Doubleday and Cresswell.

The resignations of Mrs. Wilson and McNail were read and accepted with regret.

The minutes of the March board meeting were approved as read. There was no Treasurer's report.

Mrs. Doubleday appointed as directors Mrs. Colvis, Smith, Reeder, Peterson, Mauterer and Kessler. Mrs. Mills moved, seconded by Mrs. Cresswell that they be accepted. CARRIED.

Mrs. Mills moved, seconded by Mrs. Volentine, that we send a delegate and at the cost of \$15 a visitor to the National Convention in St. Louis April 25 - 29. CARRIED. Mrs. Smith moved, seconded by Mrs. Ater, that we authorize Mrs. Doubleday to buy a reasonable amount of workshop resource material at the convention. CARRIED.

The board recommended for a National Agenda item the support of U. S. economic policy to promote world development and maintain the strength of the American economy.

Mrs. Ater gave a report on the Candidates Meeting suggesting an early start and more individual chairmen for division of responsibility.

Mrs. Mills moved, seconded by Mrs. Volentine, that the Revenue workshop be allowed \$5 for expenses for a meeting in May with an out of town speaker. CARRIED.

The program for unit meetings in April will be the Constitutional Convention in May it will be a report on the National Convention and also the National Security Seminar.

The booklet, Know Your County Government, is nearly ready for the printer.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
