Dr. Wolever worked as a psychiatrist at the Jacksonville State Hospital from 1927 to 1948. He and Portia retired to Decatur shortly after. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Jacksonville, and the Jacksonville Masonic Lodge. He and Portia had twin daughters, Elizabeth and Esther.
