MODULES IN

During 1961-62 the Decatur-Lakeview Plan was put into operation after three years of study and planning on the part of the faculty. Its purpose is to improve educational opportunities for Lakeview students by placing increased responsibility on the students for learning, by using latest research findings to determine group or class size, and by organizing the faculty into teaching teams.

In a traditional schedule students meet for one period usually 55 minutes, for 5 days a week. One

These students study independently, preparing outside assignments and projects.



The teachers on the teaching team work together to develop course content and to decide cooperatively what should be taught and how it should be presented. Emphasis is placed on the use of multimedia teaching aids in order that the students can see as well as hear the materials being presented.

ACTION

teacher is responsible for each class or group of 30 or 35 students. Under the Decatur-Lakeview Plan, students meet in classes of varying size — sometimes in small groups of 7 to 12 students and sometimes in large group classes of up to 212 students for varying lengths of time. There are fifteen modules, each lasting 27 minutes during the day. Large groups meet for one module three days a week, and small groups meet for two or three successive modules on the other two days.

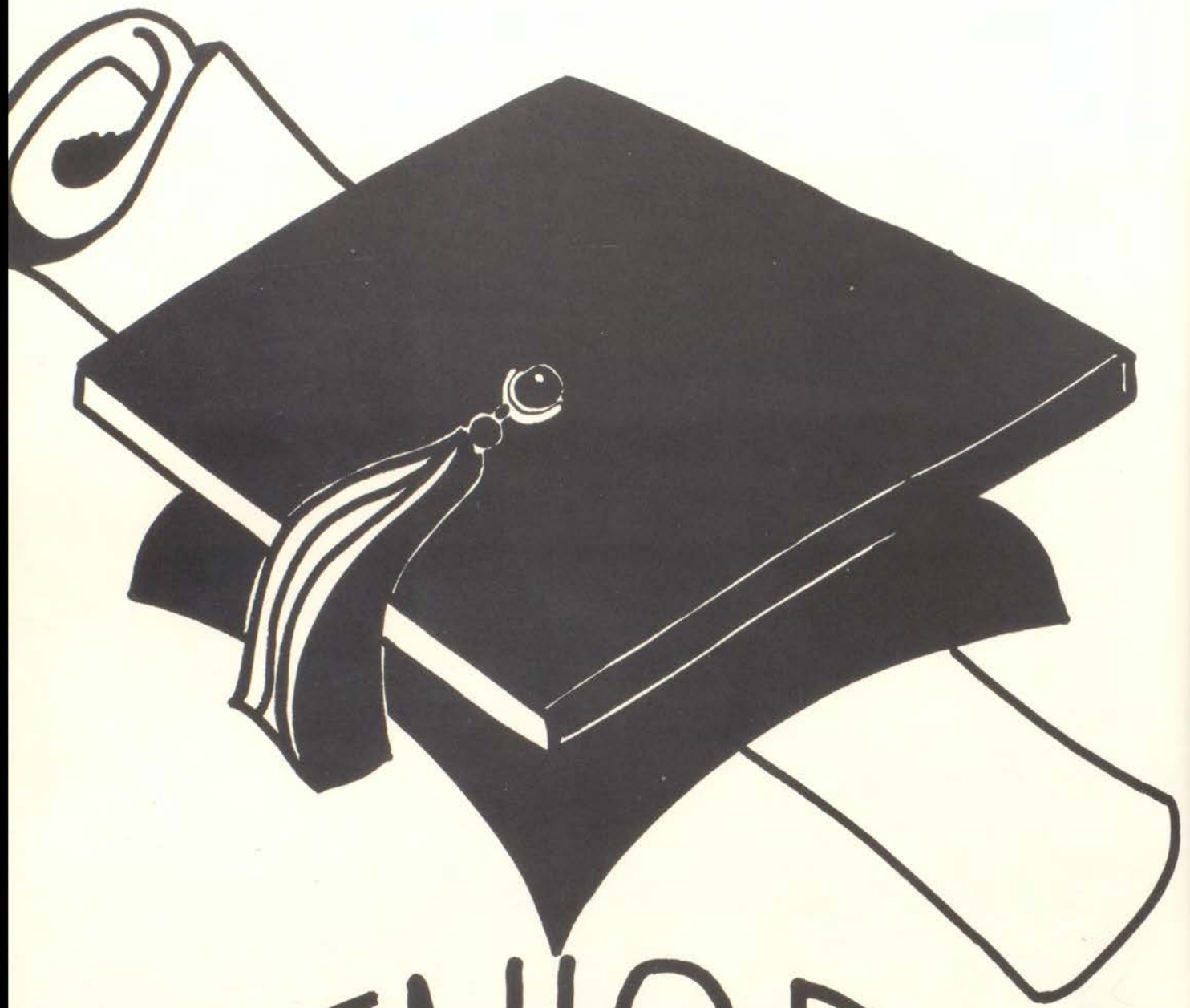

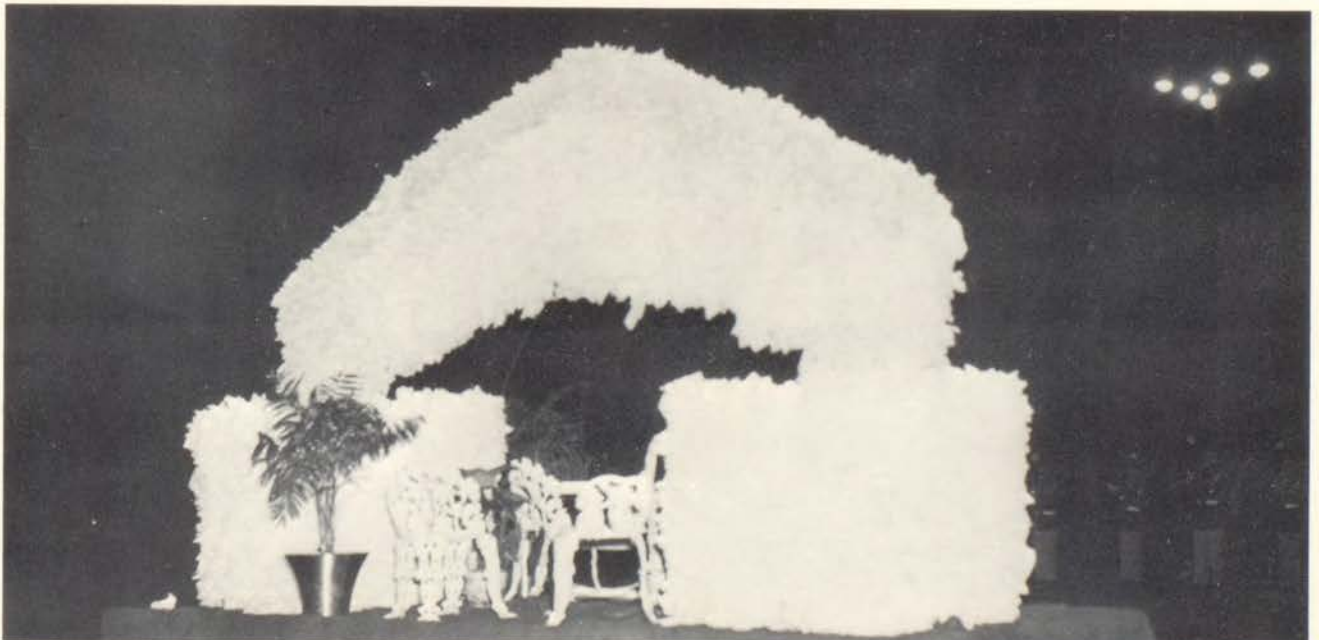

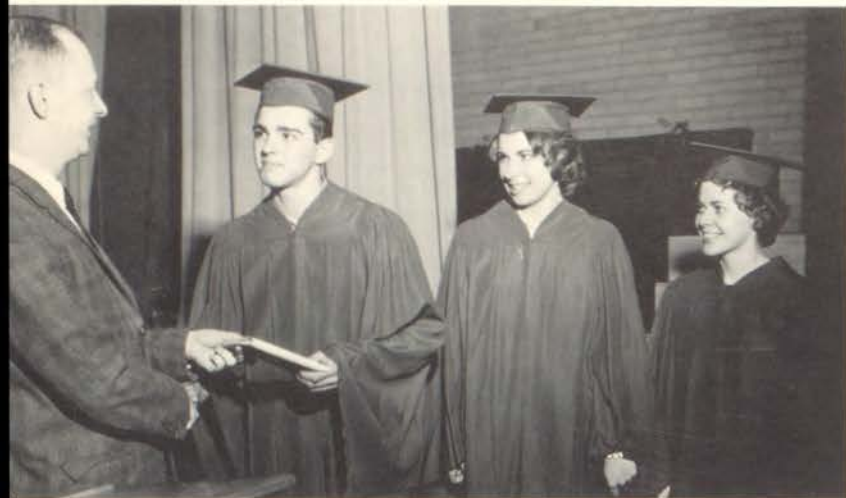
