... Have you ever taken time to laugh at something silly? Not just a snicker or a girlish giggle, but a real Santa Claus laugh ...



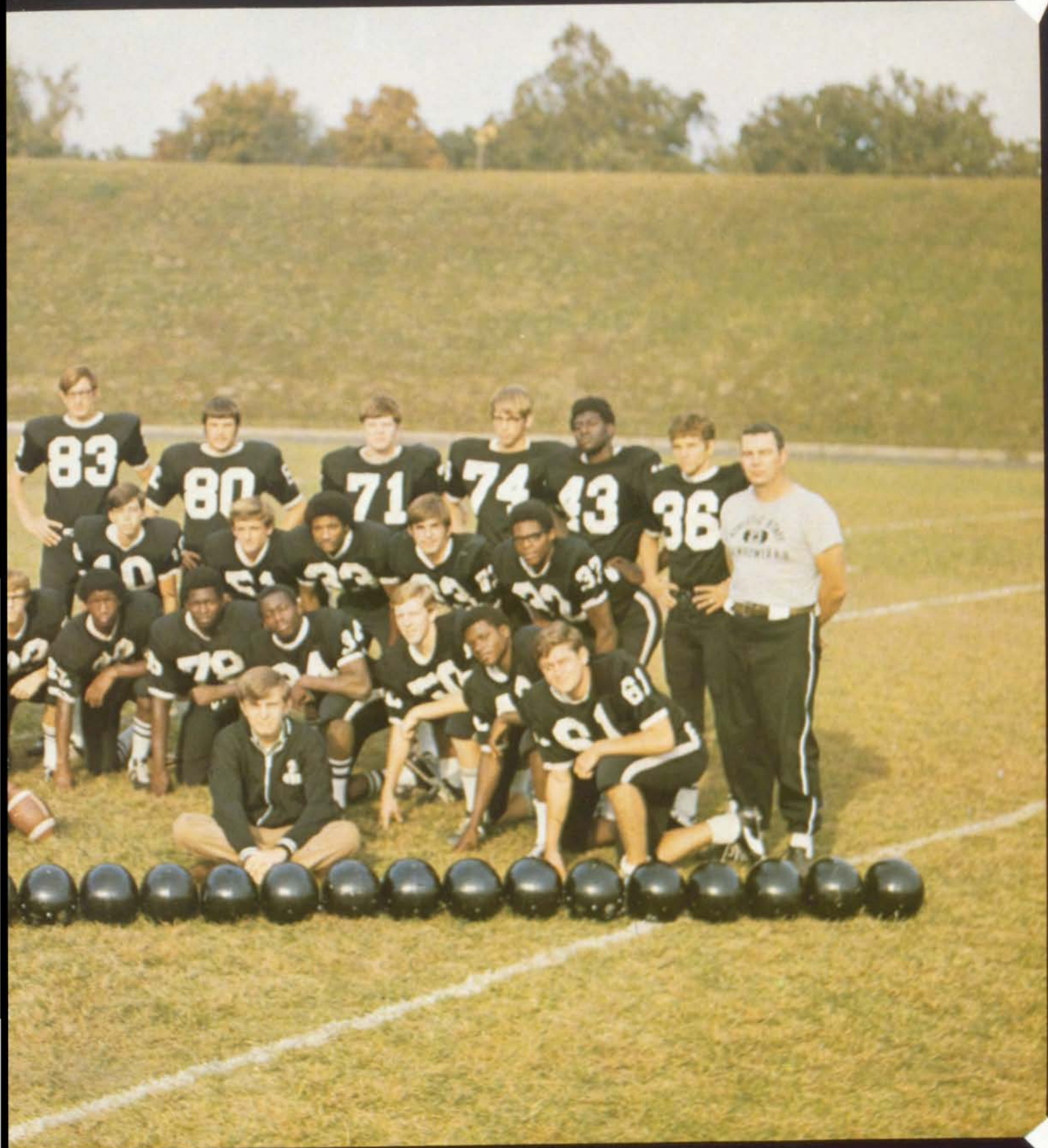

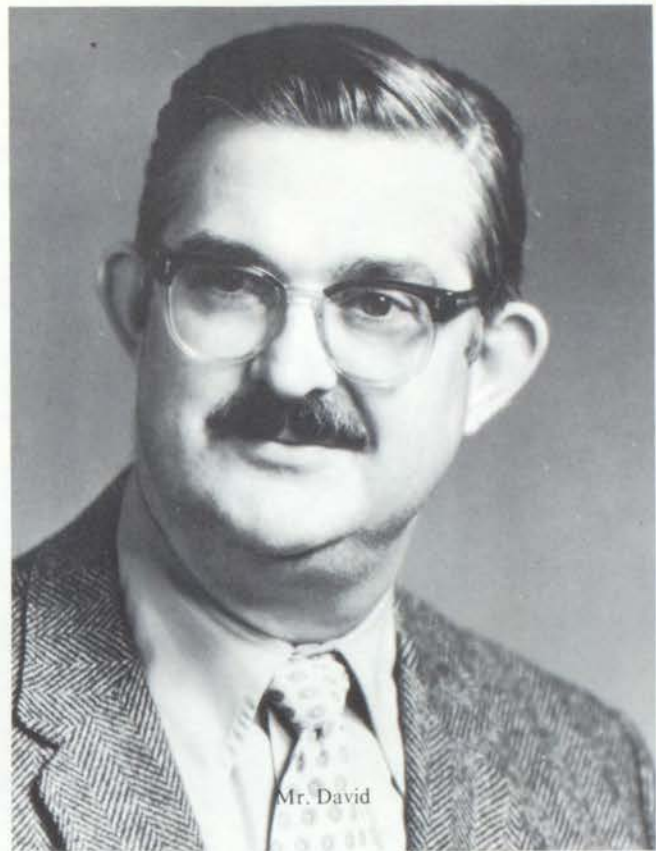


Mr. Rohrscheib
