The Children's Division reports that the following schools were winners with the highest percentage of students finishing the summer reading program:

- 1st place St. James
- 2nd place Johns Hill

Winning schools received the book: Crinkleroot's Guide to Knowing the Trees.

During the month twelve groups visited the Children's department, there were 8 lap-sits attended by 179 individuals, and there were 25 Baby TALK contacts and 26 SPARK certificates were given. Katie Gross gave a talk on " Trends in Children's Literature" for Women in the Arts on September 13th.
