The Library received a distribution of \$693.78 as its share in the income from the trust established by the will of Maude E. Bridges.

The Library also received a number of donations of books and other materials to add to its collection from various people and organizations.

No real property was acquired during the year. No personal property was purchased except for items required in the normal operation of the Library.

#### LIABILITIES

The Library had a note with First National Bank of Decatur for the upgrade of the CLSI Altos computer system. This note was paid in full during the year.
