Oriental Rug Seminar

he Homestead hosted an Oriental Rug Seminar in the North and South parlor on Saturday, October 14 from 9:00 to 11:30. Tom Meyerscough, certified appraiser and worldwide author, from the Persian Rug Center in Springfield conducted the seminar, sharing his extensive background and expertise.

Mr. Meyerscough discussed the weaving process using a loom to demonstrate how rugs are made. The history, geography, and origin of hand-made rugs were particularly interesting and informative. In addition, he provided valuable tips on the care of Oriental rugs. Participants were invited to bring a rug to show and share with the group. They each received information regarding the origin, style, age, and relative value of their rugs. Following the discussion, the group toured the Homestead to view and learn about the types of rugs in each room.


