**JOHN F. HIBBS, 71,
OF BLUE MOUND DIES**

John Franklin Hibbs, 71, of Blue Mound, died Sunday in Dwight Veterans Hospital at Dwight.

He has been ill six months.

Mr. Hibbs was a retired laborer and lived at 3600 S. Franklin Street Road before moving to Blue Mound two years ago.

He was a veteran of World War I.
