

LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS OF DECATUR
MINUTES OF BOARD MEETING
November 20, 1984

The meeting was called to order at the home of Milli Protzman at 7:00 p.m. by Andrea Bowen.

PRESENT: Milli Protzman, Laura Verbanac, Lucille Crow, Barbara Brown, Linda Hughes, Dee Meyerson. Absent: Lauri Thornton, Janet Beck, Barb Emery.

MINUTES: It was MSC (Verbanac, Protzman) that the minutes of the meeting of October 16, 1984, be approved.

ORGANIZATION: Andrea said Nominating Committee appointments would be postponed. Margaret Campbell will serve as chairwoman of the committee, and she is ill. Pat McVay has agreed to serve as chair of the Marital Laws Committee.

REPORTS:

Membership. The orientation meeting for new and prospective members was evaluated. ~~Five~~ ^{Six} to ~~ten~~ ^{eight} people attended. The board agreed that we should develop a membership flyer to be distributed by the Welcome Wagon Hostesses.

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VOTERS SERVICE. Laura Verbanac reported that we had registered 348 voters at 13 sites. League members helped with the phones at the NAACP office on election day, and at one of the sorority houses at Millikin.

Laura asked that we consider recommending a national League study to evaluate and work for changes in our method of electing the President.

Laura said that the Herald and Review Voter Supplement had been distributed to the Decatur Public Library and Senior Citizens Centers. *Nutrition Centers*
300 copies were distributed at a cost of \$25. She will write a thank-you letter to the paper for leaving their endorsements out of the supplement this time. A letter will also go to the Eagle stores for making space available for voter registration before the election.

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We have 37 paid members. Six members not yet paid are: Batson, Lantz, Oldweiler, Reynolds, Rupp, Owen. They will be called by December 1st.

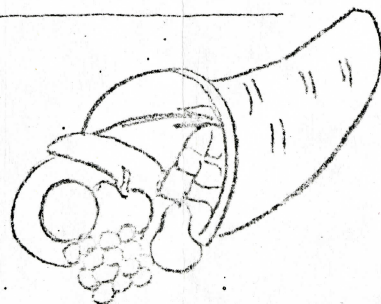

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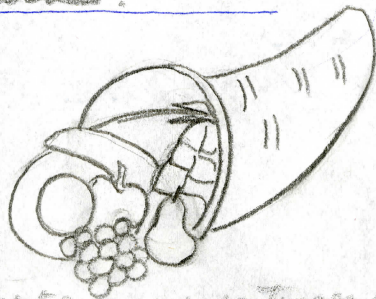
