It was reported that a "Know Your United Nations" workshop would be held here. Mrs. Pettee, Mrs. Reid, Mrs. David Wood and Mrs. Kathryn Wood will help with it.

State Drive for large individual contributions was discussed along with other correspondence received by the President.
