We wish Mrs. Birnbaum the best of luck and happiness in whatever she does.

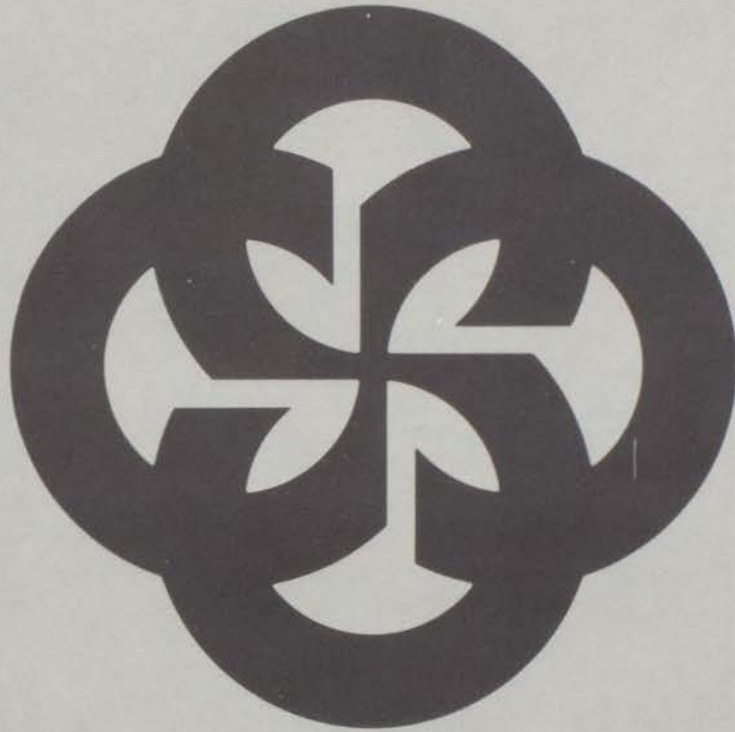
