Part of the process was to do an inventory of all the books on the list and ordering additional copies where necessary.

During the month 19 groups visited the department, bringing 328 people to the library. Preschool classes came from Head Start (8), Home-based Head Start, Mount Calvary(2) and ABC preschool. Three after-school day cares visited and classes came from South Shores, Harris and Roosevelt. Katie Gross presented a program on, "my hopes and aspirations for the new Children's Department" to a Delta Kappa Gamma group. The Macon County Reading Council met in the children's area and gave \$100 for books.

There were seven lap-sits attended by 142 and 24 Baby TALK encounters.
