### DECATUR LEAGUE PROGRAM FOR 1964-1965 (Adopted at Annual Meeting, April 1964)

#### Current Agenda:

1. A continued study of Urban Renewal in Decatur. (Mrs. John Wolf, Chmn.)
2. Take action to implement the League stand on the need for a school building program and an increase in the Education Fund tax rate; and evaluate ways to improve public education in Decatur. (Mrs. Keith Westenhaver, Chmn.)
3. A study of the advantages and disadvantages of the formation of a City of Decatur Township. (Mrs. Loring Unger, Chmn.)
4. A study of the operation and needs of the Decatur Public Library. (Mrs. Clarence Crow, Chmn.)

#### Continuing Responsibilities: (Mrs. Neal Doubleday, Chmn.)

1. Support of a sewer system which will provide all citizens of the Decatur area with adequate sanitary facilities.
2. Support of sound development of Decatur's water resources.
3. Support for the establishment and efficient operation of a county-wide Health Department.
4. Support of council-manager form of government for the City of Decatur.

## ILLINOIS LEAGUE PROGRAM FOR 1964-1965 (Adopted at State Convention, May 1963)

#### Current Agenda:

1. Evaluate the structure and financing of Illinois welfare services to children and their families. (Mrs. Morton Becker, Chmn.)
2. Study of Annual Session of Illinois General Assembly. (Adopted at Interim Council, May 1964.) (Mrs. Frank Verbanee, Chmn.)

#### Continuing Responsibilities:

1. Work for a convention to provide an improved constitution for Illinois.
2. Support a new Revenue Article giving the legislature broad power to levy the taxes necessary to provide an equitable and flexible tax structure. Under the present Revenue Article: support of corporation franchise tax, support of broadening of the base of ROT (retail occupational tax), opposition to any increase in the rate of the ROT. Support of uniform assessment practices.
3. Support of judicial reform through statutory provisions.
4. Support of statutory and constitutional revision to a) clarify and improve election laws and procedures; b) establish a central election authority; c) require certification of election judges; d) shorten the ballot; e) reduce residence requirements for voting for President and Vice President; and f) support and protect permanent registration.



(ILLINOIS PROGRAM, CONT.)

5. Protection of the citizen in his civil rights and liberties including; a) preservation of constitutional liberties; b) protection of minority groups against discrimination; c) support of a law to equalize employment opportunity in Illinois.

1. District of Columbia: Support of self-government and representation in Congress for citizens of the District of Columbia.

3. Treaty-making: Opposition to constitutional changes that would limit the existing powers of the Executive and Congress over foreign relations.
4. Loyalty Security: Support of standardized procedures, "common sense" judgment, and greatest possible protection for the individual under the federal loyalty-security program; opposition to extension of such programs to nonsensitive positions.
