We, as Seniors, will leave the yearbook to you Sophomores and Juniors, and we hope that you'll be as proud and happy with it as we have been.

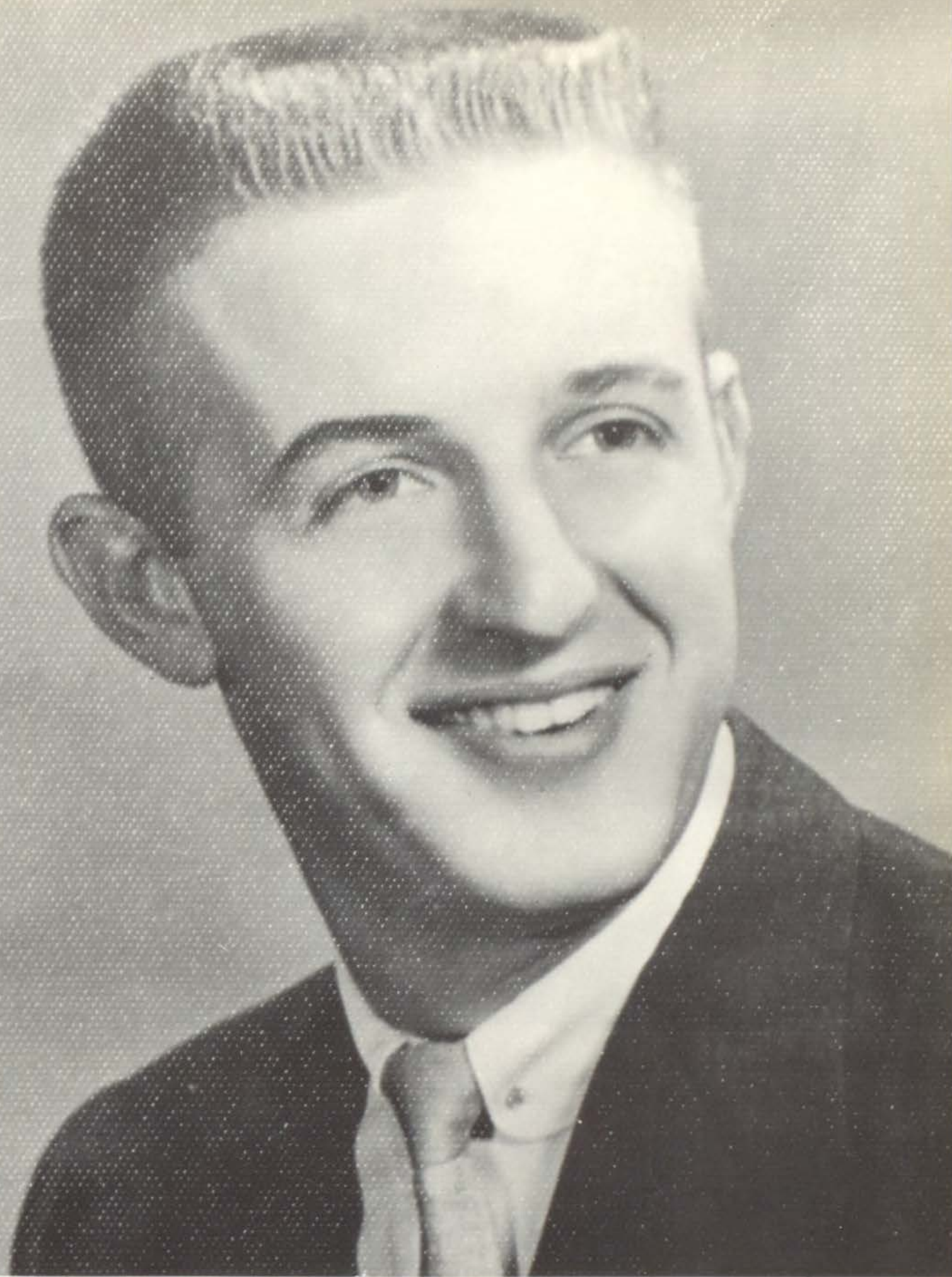

In appreciation of his faithful and constructive service to Lakeview High School, the DORIAN Staff dedicates this yearbook to Mr. Gary Lonnon.

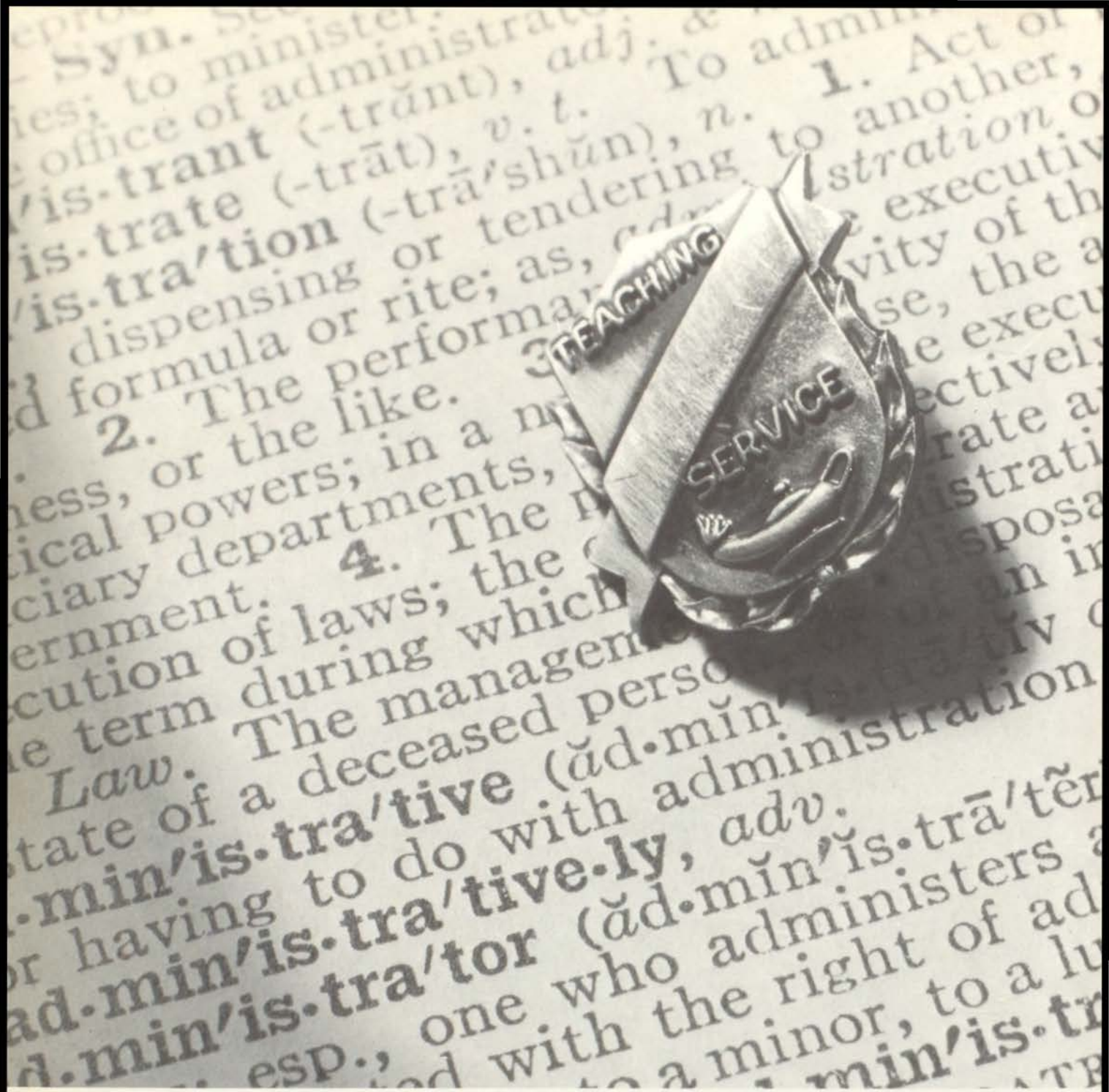

We are very proud of our Spartans, and hope the future will bring as many accomplishments.

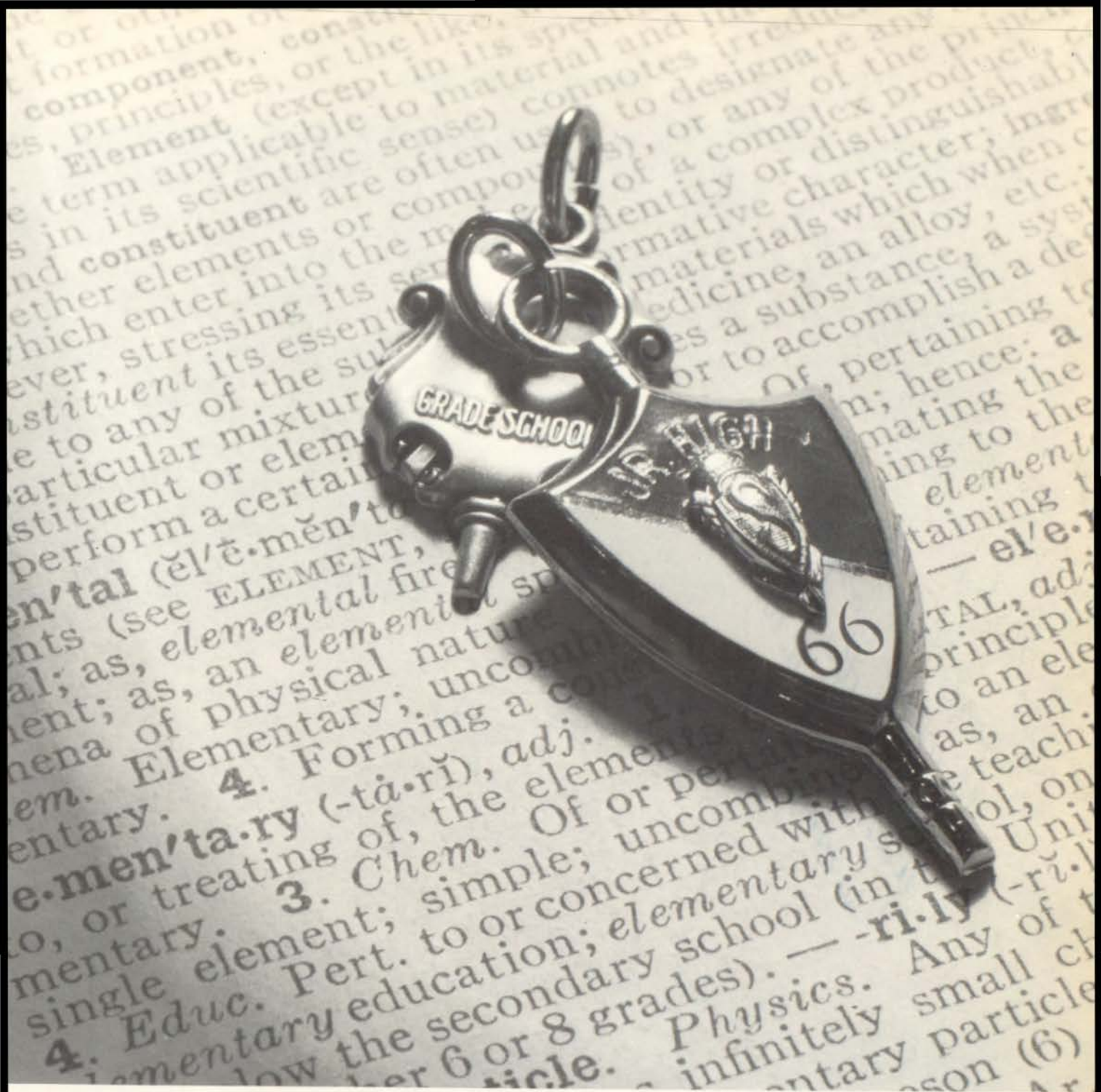
