The meeting was opened at 7:00pm. The minutes of the last meeting were approved as read. There was no treasurer's report.

There is \$530 in the Kate Beck memorial fund. We need to think of appropriate places to spend the money. We will ask Janet for suggestions.

We decided against having a rummage sale and will let Millie know.

There has been a request for a donation to the Intergenerational Project at St. Mary's.

State has suggested the 75th anniversary be celebrated with a play. Lauri volunteered to be on the play-reading committee.

Alice suggested we should be thinking of getting a group together to become knowledgeable on tax reform.
