## SYNOPSIS

Before the action begins, Nanki-Poo has fled from the court of his father, the Mikado of Japan, to escape marriage with an elderly lady named Katisha. Nanki-Poo, assuming the disguise of a musician, has fallen in love with Yum-Yum. However, he finds he cannot marry her because Ko-Ko, her guardian, wishes to marry her himself. Ko-Ko has been condemned to death for flirting, and when Act I opens, Nanki-Poo is hastening to the court of Ko-Ko in Titipu to find out whether Yum-Yum is now free to marry him.

Act II opens with Yum-Yum making preparations for her marriage to Nanki-Poo. To save Yum-Yum from that fate, Nanki-Poo decides to kill himself at once. Ko-Ko doesn't like this idea, especially since he has heard that the Mikado is at that moment on his way to Titipu. Nanki-Poo then offers himself for decapitation, but Ko-Ko is unable to perform the act without some practice.

Ko-Ko then has another idea: make a false affidavit that Nanki-Poo has been executed, and then have Nanki-Poo and Yum-Yum leave the country.

The Mikado soon appears. Ko-Ko thinks that the object of this visit is to see whether or not the execution has taken place. He produces the affidavit, and with gusto he describes the execution. The Mikado has actually come, at the prompting of Katisha, in search of his lost son. When it appears that Ko-Ko has executed the Mikado's son, Ko-Ko and his accomplices are declared guilty of "compassing the death of the Heir Apparent." The only hope for them is to admit the falsehood of the affidavit and produce Nanki-Poo alive. Since Nanki-Poo has already married Yum-Yum and so cannot marry Katisha, Katisha will surely insist on the execution of Nanki-Poo and Yum-Yum. Ko-Ko solves the problem by offering his hand to Katisha and she accepts him.

The story ends with Nanki-Poo's appearance before the Mikado.

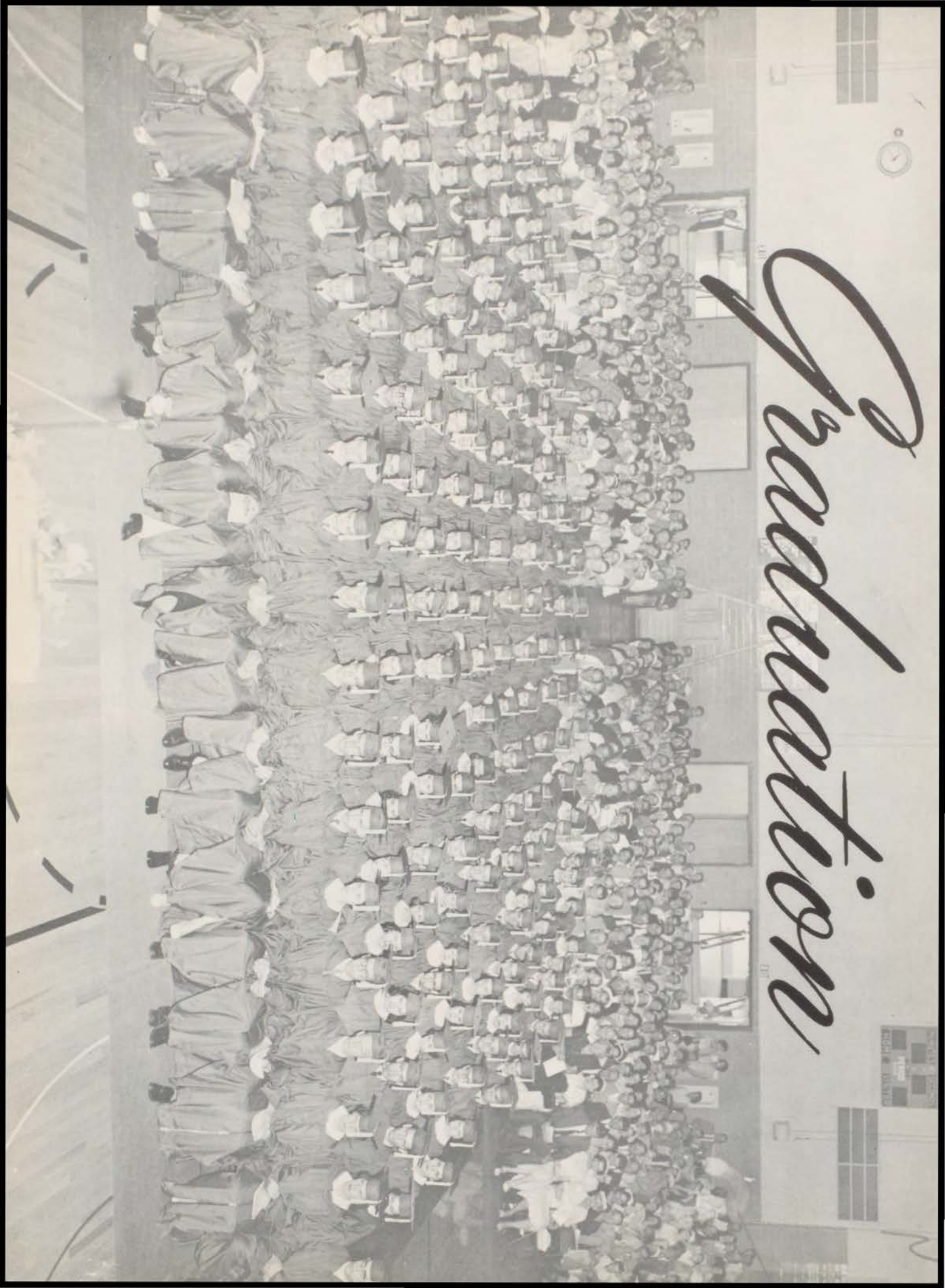
