WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters is an outstanding and influential civic organization, and

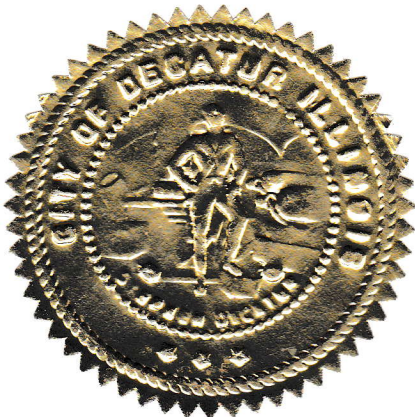
WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters provides non-partisan and objective information on candidates and issues, presents candidates to the public as a civic service, and
