DECATUR LEAGUE PROGRAM FOR 1965-1966

(Adopted at Annual Meeting, May 12, 1965)

Current Agenda:

I. Macon County Nursing Home:

Study of the need for a county nursing home.

II. Decatur Public Library:

1. Support for a new main library building.
2. Continued study of the operation and needs of the library.

III. Decatur Public Schools:

1. Support of measures to provide adequate space and education programs.
2. Study of ways to improve public education in Decatur.

IV. Urban Renewal:

1. Support of urban renewal neighborhood rehabilitation and spot clearance projects.
2. Study to establish criteria for determining need for total clearance.

Continuing Responsibilities

- I. Support of a sewer system which will provide all citizens of the Decatur area with adequate facilities.
- II. Support of sound development of Decatur's water resources.
- III. Support of efficient development and operation of the Macon County Health Department.
- IV. Support of Council-Manager form of government for the City of Decatur.

ILLINOIS LEAGUE PROGRAM FOR 1965-1967

(Adopted at State Convention, April, 1965)

I. To Welfare: Support of improved Illinois welfare services to children and their families.

II. Constitutional Revisions: Work for a constitutional convention for Illinois and for improvement of the structure of Illinois government by constitutional revision to include:

1. A new Revenue Article giving the legislature broad power to levy the taxes needed to provide an equitable and flexible tax structure.
2. Annual sessions for the Illinois General Assembly.
3. A short ballot.
4. Protection of the 1962 Judicial Amendment.

III. Protection of the individual in his civil rights and liberties:

1. Study of equal housing opportunities.
2. Support of legislation to equalize employment opportunities.
3. Preservation of constitutional liberties.

IV. Election Laws: Support of statutory measures that:

1. Clarify and improve election laws and procedures.
2. Establish a central election authority.
3. Require certification of election judges.
4. Protect reduced residence requirements for voting for President & Vice President.
5. Protect permanent registration.

V. Judicial Reform: Support of statutory provisions to implement the Judicial article.

NATIONAL LEAGUE PROGRAM FOR 1964-1966

(Adopted at National Conv., April, 1964)

1. **Development of Human Resources:** Evaluation of policies and programs in the United States to provide for all citizens equality of opportunity for education and employment.
2. **United Nations:** Support of U.S. policies which strengthen the United Nations system and its ability to keep the peace.
3. **Foreign Economic Policy:** Support of U.S. policies which promote world economic development, maintain a sound U.S. economy, and further international and regional cooperation.
4. **Water Resources:** Support of national policies and procedures which promote comprehensive long-range planning for conservation and development of water resources.
5. **Apportionment of State Legislatures:** Evaluation of the basis of representation which shall govern the apportionment of state legislatures as established by the Federal Constitution and statutory provisions. *Adopted by National Council May, 1965.

Continuing Responsibilities

1. **District of Columbia:** Support of self-government and representation in Congress for citizens of the District of Columbia.
2. **Tax Rates:** Opposition to constitutional limitations on tax rates.
3. **Treaty-Making:** Opposition to constitutional changes that would limit the existing powers of

Continuing Responsibilities:

3. **the Executive and Congress over foreign relations.**
4. **Loyalty Security:** Support of standardized procedures, "common sense" judgment, and greatest possible protection for the individual under the federal loyalty-security program; opposition to extension of such programs to nonsensitive positions.


