MINUTES OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING - JANUARY 12, 1968

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DECATUR PUBLIC LIBRARY WAS HELD ON JANUARY 12, 1968 IN THE BOARD ROOM OF THE MAIN LIBRARY.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 4:35 P.M. BY MR. OLSEN.

THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR BOARD MEETING OF DECEMBER 15, 1967 WERE APPROVED.

CITY LIBRARIAN ROBERT DUMAS REPORTED THAT THERE WAS NO MARKED DEVIATION IN CIRCULATION TRENDS FROM LAST MONTH. THE CENTRAL ADULT DEPARTMENT CONTINUES TO SHOW A SMALL INCREASE; EXTENSION CIRCULATION WAS STILL DOWN ABOUT 9%. HOWEVER, TOTAL CIRCULATION REMAINS ON PAR WITH JANUARY OF LAST YEAR, RATHER THAN SHOWING A DECLINE AS HAS BEEN TRUE FOR THE PAST FEW MONTHS.

MR. DUMAS FURTHER REPORTED THAT THE SCHEDULE OF BOARD MEETINGS FOR THE COM-ING YEAR HAS BEEN POSTED PUBLICLY AND PUBLISHED IN THE NEWSPAPER IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE LAW.

CHAIRMAN OF THE PROPERTIES AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, MR. MILLER, GAVE AN INFORMATIONAL REPORT ON THE SUMMARY OF INCOME AND EXPENDITURES THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 1967 AND BILLS APPROVED THROUGH DECEMBER 22, 1967. THE MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF THE REPORT BY MR. MILLER WAS SECONDED BY MR. SAPPINGTON AND WAS UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED BY A ROLL-CALL VOTE.

MR. MILLER FURTHER MOVED THAT:

\$25.00 BE TRANSFERRED FROM CONTINGENCIES, CODE 402, TO OTHER INSURANCE, CODE 423; AND THAT \$100.00 BE TRANSFERRED FROM CONTINGENCIES, CODE 402, TO MATERIALS TO MAINTAIN AUTOMOTIVE EQUIPMENT, CODE 324.

THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY MR. FREYFOGLE AND WAS APPROVED.

MR. SAPPINGTON, CHAIRMAN OF THE POLICIES, PUBLIC RELATIONS AND PERSONNEL COMMITTEE, STATED THAT HIS COMMITTEE DID NOT MEET DURING THE PAST MONTH BECAUSE OF THE INABILITY TO SECURE A QUORUM. HOWEVER, MR. SAPPINGTON STATED THAT HE THOUGHT IT WOULD BE OF INTEREST TO THE BOARD TO KNOW THAT ALL DEPARTMENT HEADS OF THE CITY HAD RECEIVED A 15% INCREASE IN SALARY AS OF JANUARY 1, AND AS CHAIRMAN OF HIS COMMITTEE AND AS A MEMBER OF HIS COMMITTEE HE WOULD LIKE TO ASK FOR AN EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE BOARD FOR THE PURPOSE OF DISCUSSING THE SALARY OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE LIBRARY. THE BOARD WENT INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION AT APPROXIMATELY 4:45 P.M.

THE BOARD RECONVENED AT 4:50 P.M. AT WHICH TIME MR. SAPPINGTON MADE THE FOLLOWING MOTION:

THAT THE CITY LIBRARIAN BE GRANTED AN INCREASE IN SALARY IN THE AMOUNT OF 15% OF HIS PRESENT BASE SALARY AND THAT THIS INCREASE BE EFFECTIVE AS OF THE TIME THAT THE OTHER CITY DEPARTMENT HEADS RECEIVED THEIR RAISES, THE FIRST OF JANUARY, 1968.

MR. FREYFOGLE SECONDED THE MOTION AND THE MOTION CARRIED.

MR. SAPPINGTON WANTED THE RECORD TO SHOW THAT HE HAD DOUBTS AS TO WHETHER THE LEGISLATURE INTENDED FOR ALL CITY EMPLOYEES TO RECEIVE A 15% INCREASE WHEN IT (THE LEGISLATURE) VOTED THE MINIMUM SALARIES FOR POLICEMEN AND FIREMEN. HOWEVER, SINCE IT WAS GRANTED, HE VOTED FOR IT FOR THE DIRECTOR OF THE LIBRARY.

MR. SAPPINGTON REPORTED THAT THE CITY MANAGER ADVISED MR. DUMAS THAT THE CITY WAS HAVING A CLASSIFICATION STUDY UNDERTAKEN BY AN OUTSIDE FIRM AND THAT MR. DUMAS INDICATED THAT THE LIBRARY WOULD LIKE TO BE INCLUDED, THAT HIS COMMITTEE REAFFIRMED THIS REQUEST, AND THAT CONSEQUENTLY THE LIBRARY IS TO BE STUDIED IN THE SALARY EVALUATION SURVEY.

THE NEXT REGULAR BOARD MEETING IS TO BE HELD FEBRUARY 16, 1968 IN THE BOARD ROOM OF THE MAIN LIBRARY.

THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED AT 5:55 P.M.
