Long Range Planning Committee October 24, 1994

Stan Sitton called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. Members present: Karen Anderson, Bev Freeman, John Moorman, George Nichols, Herb Dakin, Stan Sitton, and Joann Stanbery.

The minutes of the meeting of October 3, 1994 were approved as mailed.

Exterior building goals, bookmobiles, and parking were discussed. It was suggested that the library request a "first right of refusal" on the bowling alley and the Futures building which are just south of the library.

A possible branch was discussed but the consensus was that it was not feasible at this time. A bookmobile could go to a lot more locations and provide greater flexibility.

Both large bookmobiles will be on the road until June 1. At that time, one of the bookmobiles may be taken off the road and use of the smaller unit will be expanded.

The roof is in very bad shape. The Library Board will be asking the City Council to replace the roof as part of the City's capital budget.

Signage was also discussed in conjunction with improved community awareness and library programs. The possibility of a large sign outside will be reviewed with the architect.

The need for a continued stairway gallery for the art work each month was noted.

The need for another citizen survey in 1997 was noted.

The next meetings will be November 14, November 21, and December 19. The meeting was adjourned at 6:00 p.m.
