BOARD MEETING December 8, 1950

The Board of the Macon County League of Women Voters met on December 8, 1950, at two o'clock in the Association of Commerce Conference Room, with ten members present.

The meeting was called to order by the Fresident, Mrs. Birt, and the Secre minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. The Treasurer's Report showed a balance on hand of \$530.84. The Treasurer's Report was accepted as read.

Mrs. Birt stated that the League now has 71 paid members. There are two new members, Katherine Patterson and Mrs. George F. Myers.

Mrs. Birt read excerpts from Mrs. Lee's last letter. Among other things, the letter stated the League publications and circulation of Trends are up 10%. The daily publication sales are double for the same period last year.

Mrs. Ruedi moved that the League send tlegrams to both Senators and Congressman to the effect that the State local League would be in favor of combatting inflation. It was decided that Mrs. Wood, Mrs. Smith and Mrs. Donovan draft the telegrams to be sent. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Lupton and passed.

Mrs. Birt reported on the Council Meeting held in Chicago, at which the Presidents of the various Leagues were present. She stated that representatives from 45 Leagues were present. She reported that the meetings were most interesting, being keyed up by the National situation. The morning session was devoted almost entirely to Local and State Program, and our Mrs. Sanders made one of a five-member Committee appointed for Constitutional Revision.

The President remided the Board that the local Primary is February 27th and the election April 17th. A Candidates' Meeting was decided upon and Mrs. Lewis was appointed Chairman of this Meeting.

Mrs. Birt expressed extreme regret over the fact that our most capable Treasurer, Ars. Catt, is moving out of the city, and stated she will appoint a new Treasurer to fill the vacancy. The next meetings at the Libarary will be on Wednesday, January 24th, and February 28th. The discussion group meetings will be on January 11th at 9:30 A.M. and 2:00 P.M. and the home of Mrs. Robert Lewis.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
