Any membership monies received after mid-November 2021 have been credited to the membership year that begins on March 1, 2022.


Around the House

The long-awaited restoration work on the Southwest Porch began in mid-November 2021. This first phase includes the columns (up to the ornamental work), upper rails, balustrades, lower rails, deck, and the door.

Restoration carpenter, Dan Janvrin, removed the rails, balustrades, and columns cautiously to preserve the pieces for restoration true to the originals. Dan took the rails and balustrades to the Millikin University Facilities shop to make indoor repairs during the winter months. He replaced rotted wood and carefully replicated the detail of the original porch rails. Dan continues with this task to put final changes and professional touches on his work. Volunteers will finish the deck and door in the spring. Millikin Facilities will give a final paint coat for the railings after the weather warms.

We owe a great deal of thanks to Millikin University's Ruby James, Vice President/Finance; James Fraley, V.P. Facilities Management; Shane Brocken, Facilities Operations and Maintenance Manager; and Dan Janvrin, Staff Preservation Carpenter for the contribution of labor and strategic planning. Furthermore, we are indebted to the generosity in cash and materials from the John Ullrich Foundation for a grant, the Decatur Surf Club for a donation of materials and paint, and Joanne Hantel for a donation. Without these benevolent grantors and donors this work would not be possible.

Building and Grounds Committee Chair, Deb Scheiter, tells us the next phase will be the upper portion of the front (East facing) porch. Then, Phase III will come back to the Southwest Porch and work on the upper portions of that area. And the closing or final portion of porch work will be the first-floor portion of the Front Porch (Phase IV) planned for 2023. See the contrasting photos "Old" and "New":
