MINUTES

Board Meeting, League of Women Voters of Decatur -- February 19, 1991  
Held in home of L.Crow

Present: A.Dupree, L.Thornton, S.Dizio, M.Protzman, B.Brown,  
L.Verbanac, K.Owen, L.Crow.

1. Minutes of January 15, 1991 Board Meeting were approved.
2. Treasurer reported cash on hand this date is \$2,668.05. Education Fund Balance is \$316.20. Treasurer will pay final quarter of State PMP. Total National PMP has been paid.

3. Announcements: Andrea Bowen's new address: 1706 Cardinal Way, Macomb, Il. 61455, Telephone: 308-833-4608.

Call to State Convention to be held May 17-19, at Lisle. Our League will be entitled to two delegates plus president or designated person. Early registration will mean a discount in fee.

State League asks for nominations for "Something Special Awards" to be announced at State Convention. The president and L. Crow will write up our activities in voter registration and candidates meetings for the past year.

Tax Payers Choice--Letter from National noting we can get a write-off on our federal income tax of one dollar each to support the president's campaign. League support is under our Campaign Reform position.

Local president and Voter Service Chairman will fill out questionnaire to report obstacles to Voter Registration drives. National League is pushing to get Motor-Voter Bill passed. League will help in survey of obstacles to polling places in 40 local precincts, 18 of which have been noted to have obstacles for handicapped voters.

4. Reports: S.Dizio asked board approval for questions to be mailed to candidates appearing at our Candidates for City Council Meeting to be held at the Library Auditorium, March 21, at 7:00 PM. Following discussion, approval granted. Four minutes will be allowed for opening statements by the candidates, two minutes for responses to questions, and three minutes for closing statements. League will need a display and League banner. WSOY will broadcast meeting.

State League will have a petition drive for Motor-voter Act. Notice will be in DECATUR VOTER.

Deadline for DECATUR VOTER will be board meeting date or within a few days following.

5. Program: General Membership meeting at First United Methodist Church, March 12, at 7:30PM. Topic: Child Care. Speaker: Ellen Stogsdill, Adm. of Anna Waters Head Start Center. K.Owen to call church morning of meeting to have meeting room door unlocked.

Board approved proposed Concurrence on County Government Structure. Concurrence obtained at Feb. 12, general meeting. President will send Concurrence approval and comments to State League.

Champaign County Health Care Consumers will hold conference at Jumer's Lodge, March 16, at Noon. Registration required but no fee.

Program Cont'd: A National Health Care Study group will be formed.

April 9, General Meeting on Financing Delivery of Health Care at First United Methodist Church, 7:30PM. Program Chairman will ask Sally Soper or someone from local Social Security Office to speak.

Legislative Seminar in Springfield, April 23 and 24. Will be noted in DECATUR VOTER.

Annual Meeting, May 14. Will be a salad supper at the home of M. Protzman. Will ask State Board member, Sandy Vogue, to be speaker. Will need report by Nominating Committee and Budget Committee at Annual Meeting. Ann Limerick is chairman of Nominating Committee. L. Thornton will represent Board. Non-member of Board to be named. K. Owen and B. Brown will serve on Budget Committee. Non-Board chairman to be named.

Summer coffee in June to be planned. Will hear reports from State Convention.

6. Finance Drive Chairman reported contributions from mail campaign of \$265 to local league and \$25 earmarked for State League Education Fund. Expenses were \$43, leaving balance of \$247 for finance drive.

7. New Business: President asked for suggestions regarding letter she has written to be sent to new or prospective members listing opportunities or options for involvement available to members.

Legislative visits. L. Verbanac and L. Crow will interview Rep. Noland. A. Dupree and L. Thornton will interview Reps. Severns and Dunn. K. Owen will be alternate.

Andrea Bowen has written about the death of our Secretary, June Redpath, for the DECATUR VOTER. The president read a letter she has written to June's family noting our love for her and that a list of checks presented to the League in June's memory will be sent to them.

A date in September-October has board approval for a rummage sale.

March 19, Board meeting will be in the home of K. Owen, 197. N. Woodlawn.

April 16, Board meeting will be in home of L. Crow.

DECATUR — June M. Redpath, 70, of Decatur died 12:13 a.m. Thursday (Feb. 7, 1991) in Decatur Memorial Hospital.

Memorial services will be 2:30 p.m. Saturday in Dawson & Wikoff West Wood Street Funeral Home. Graveside services will be 11 a.m. Saturday (Feb. 16, 1991) in Grace-land Cemetery. Memorials: Hu-mane Society.

Mrs. Redpath was born in Chicago June 20, 1920, daughter of George and Ethel Grinley. She was an elementary schoolteacher, having taught for 25 years in Decatur schools. She received her B.A. from Northwestern Univer-sity and her Master of Education from the University of Illinois. She was a member of Decatur, state and national Retired Teachers as-sociations and was on the execu-tive board for the Decatur Retired Teachers Association. She was a member of First Presbyterian Church and Great Book Club, and was secretary of League of Women Voters.

She is survived by her sons, Robert Redpath of Decatur; James E. Redpath Jr. of Morton; five grandchildren.

Her parents preceded her in death.
