MINUTES OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING - SEPTEMBER 15, 1967

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DECATUR PUBLIC LIBRARY WAS HELD ON SEPTEMBER 15, 1967 IN THE BOYD ROOM OF THE MAIN LIBRARY.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 4:35 P.M. BY MR. OLSEN.

THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR BOARD MEETING OF AUGUST 21, 1967 WERE APPROVED.

MR. DUMAS STATED THAT CIRCULATION THIS MONTH IS STILL ABOVE LAST YEAR, BUT THAT THE TOTAL INCREASE WAS LOWER THAN IT HAS BEEN. THERE WAS AN INCREASE IN CENTRAL, BUT A DROP IN THE EXTENSION AGENCIES.

MR. MILLER, CHAIRMAN OF THE PROPERTIES AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, GAVE AN INFORMATIONAL REPORT ON THE SUMMARY OF INCOME AND EXPENDITURES THROUGH AUGUST 31, 1967 AND BILLS APPROVED THROUGH AUGUST 22, 1967. THE REPORT WAS UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED BY A ROLL-CALL VOTE.

AS A MEMBER OF THE POLICIES, PUBLIC RELATIONS AND PERSONNEL COMMITTEE, MR. SCHUERMAN MOVED THAT THE CITY LIBRARIAN BE AUTHORIZED AT HIS DISCRETION TO CANCEL FINES AND OTHER DELINQUENT RECORDS FOR MINORS WHO ARE CURRENTLY RESIDING IN WEBSTER HALL, CANTRELL HALL, OR OTHER SIMILAR INSTITUTION, PROVIDING THE DELINQUENCY OCCURRED PRIOR TO ESTABLISHMENT OF RESIDENCE AT SUCH AN INSTITUTION. THE MOTION CARRIED.

MR. SCHUERMAN FURTHER MOVED THAT THE CITY LIBRARIAN BE AUTHORIZED TO INSTITUTE CIVIL PROCEEDINGS AGAINST PATRONS WITH DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS. THE MOTION WAS DISCUSSED AND IT WAS DECIDED TO POSTPONE ACTION. HOWEVER, UPON THE ARRIVAL OF MR. SAPPINGTON, CHAIRMAN OF THE POLICIES, PUBLIC RELATIONS AND PERSONNEL COMMITTEE, DISCUSSION OF THE MOTION WAS RE-OPENED. MR. SAPPINGTON STATED THAT HE BELIEVED THE MOTION SHOULD BE PASSED AS WRITTEN. HE THEREFORE MOVED THAT THE CITY LIBRARIAN BE AUTHORIZED TO INSTITUTE CIVIL PROCEEDINGS AGAINST PATRONS WITH DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS. THE MOTION WAS ADOPTED.

MR. SAPPINGTON MOVED THAT A FULL-TIME LIBRARY PAGE POSITION, IN PAY GRADE 5, BE CREATED. THE MOTION CARRIED.

MR. SAPPINGTON MOVED THAT THE LIST OF PAID HOLIDAYS GRANTED TO LIBRARY EMPLOYEES BE AMENDED TO INCLUDE OCTOBER 12, COLOMBUS DAY. MR. FREYFOGLE STRONGLY OBJECTED TO THE MOTION. MR. OLSEN STATED THAT IT HAD BEEN THE POLICY OF THE BOARD IN THE PAST TO ALIGN ITSELF WITH THE POLICIES OF THE CITY INSOFAR AS POSSIBLE. MR. FREYFOGLE REQUESTED THAT A RE-EXAMINATION OF THE HOLIDAY SCHEDULE BE MADE IN ORDER TO KEEP THE LIBRARY OPEN AS MANY HOLIDAYS AS POSSIBLE. MR. SAPPINGTON STATED THAT THIS WOULD BE DONE. MR. DUMAS AGREED WITH THE DESIRABILITY OF REMAINING OPEN AS MANY HOLIDAYS AS POSSIBLE, BUT POINTED OUT THAT THE PRESENT STAFF SHORTAGE MADE FOR A DIFFICULT SITUATION. AFTER THIS DISCUSSION, THE MOTION CARRIED.
