## Harch 26, 1971

The meeting was held at the home of Mrs. Robert Schade, 143 Foint Bluff Drive, with President, Mrs. Schade presiding.

PRESERT: Hesdames Schade, Leyerson, Dunas, Coberly, Ohlsen, Meiman, Panetti, Lauterjung, Forbes, Harshall, and Verbanac.

ABORNT: Resdates Butler, Rughes, Hippler, Lantz, Forbes, and Grow.

LINUTES: The minutes were approved as nailed.

TREASURERS REPORT: There was no report of cash on hand due to absence of treasurer.

The Citizens Committee for a New Constitution has donated a surplus of campaign funds totaling ABh.h6 to League. Ers. Schade read the accompanying letter from Lr. Gene Brown.

Med BUSIMESU: Resignations were accepted for the second year as an elected directed from Irs. Panetti, Ers. Danas, Ers. Verbanac, and Ers. Meinman.

AMECUNICIAMITS: 1) Taped National Consensus Reports may be heard by calling League Spot Haster in Washington. The number is 202-296-0218. We will make this known to the media. The environmental convensus will be on from Friday, April 16 thru Honday, April 19. 2) Law of U.S. has announced that a new Strategy for Action Committee is in operation. It decides priorities and where League can be nost effective. 3) The Brookline, hass. League has asked us to recommend that an o lorgency item be adopted at Mational Council, May 3. The item would be Study of the Role of the Hilitary and Intelligence Agencies In the Formulation of Foreign rolicy and Their Role in Intervention into Domestic Affairs of Other Hations. The Board discussed this and the decision was that a mini-study (which is implied by being an emergency item) could not be conducted in the traditionally thorough League manner. A major extended study would be necessary. This feeling will be conveyed to the Mational Board. h) League's Open Door Herbership Policy is being challenged. An effort will be made to get more minority group members. Chicago had a meeting with all its black members to discuss what's wrong and what's needed to get more blacks. 5) A new publication Current Focus, "The Voter, The Law and The Ballot" was suggested for mailing to all members or on subscription service. Cost - 10¢ per copy - less in bulk. It was passed around and the decision was made to order enough for all members and a few for other interested people. 6) A new Report From The Hill was passed around. 7) A new publication The Indian and Proud of It, was passed around. 8) No minations for National Office have been asked for by the National Moninating Correittee. We will enter none at this time. 9) Highland Park League has proposed a new type of state organization. It would be a task force set up on the county level as an arm to the State Board. 10) The new State President's Letter has an insort that names bills of league commern presently in the legislature and where League stam's on the .. It will be printed in the Voter. 11) Speaker for the State Convention Banquet will be James Ahern,

he ber of the Serenton Con ission on campus unrest. 12) The question of a Town Lecting being held this year was raised and discussed. 113) League desires that the General Assistance Program be assimilated with federal programs and not under township supervision. 1h) Laterial was received from the Freedom of Residence group. They would like a League person to be a director. Anyone interested may have the materials. 15) A statement was received from MSOI showing donation of \$119.00 in ad lib spots. 16) A letter was received from MSOI showing donation of Gounty Government Neck thanking League for its participation in the opening coremony. 17) A thank you was received from John Ziese for the opportunity to appear at the City Council candidates pecting. 18) Received "Excerpts from Selected Executive Documents" from the State of Illinois Information Service.

Anyone interested may get them from Ers. Schoole to read. 19) An interesting letter concerning "generation gap" was passed around.

Election Lous: Consensus was read and discussed. It was moved, seconded, and passed to approve and send it to State as subsitted. A copy is filed with the minutes.

U. S. Congress: An all member neeting will be April lh at 7:30 P. ... A film will be shown at this informational meeting.

"Facts and Issues On U.S. Congress" will go out on subscription service.

A committee guide for U.S. Congress was received. Its glossary of congressional terms will be put in the Voter or passed out at the all member meeting.

Decatur behools: Since number of school board candidates has balloomed, the question of cost of printing 3,000 information sheets was raised. A possibility is working with the newspaper to print the information and the rTA to copy the information. Only five candidates have replied at this date. Are, Reverson and Frs. Ohlson will decide what to do after Ronday, Earch 29. We might just print enough for our members and the media.

The Social Studies Task Force in the public schools has asked league for a representative to appear before it to make suggestions or express views and comments on 1) that aspects of social studiesheed special emphasis, and 2) that are the special needs of this committy. The board authorized has Ohlsen and has Verbanac to compose the state ent according to league's general philosophy of government.

Burnan Resources: A request to rite letters was given to the Torrence Park Citizens Committee, U. D.O. and Welfare Rights Organization,

Firs. Verbanac brought to the attention of the Board that the counittee has need of a local consensus. League has been asked to act by signing petitions for local action. The con ittee feels it imporative that last year's report be updated with consensus taken on a) urban renewal areas, b) public housing sites, and c) neighborhood redevelopment projects. The Board authorized the condittee to write consensus questions concerning the listed housing areas.

A re inder was made to the Board to ask for local consensus fore often so that action where necessary on the local level would be possible.

A letter was received from are. Thomas Protz an. She's working on a proposed constitution for Ohio. Our material, especially emaples of promotional materials used in the Illinois or paign has been quite helpful.

The Ad Hoc Condittee for A Juvenile Detention Center has asked League to join. A 5.0 fee will be paid fro the treasury and Irs. Coberly will represent League on the corrittee.

Environmental Quality: A letter from State suggested that we oppose an extension of variance by the Pollution Control Board to the Decatur Sanitary District according to National concensus. We prefer not to do this since we feel the Docatur District is trying with funds available.

A suggestion was made to exphasize to new members that League is not a social organization and valco es members of all econo ic status.
