

MINUTES OF CALLED BOARD MEETING
LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS, DECATUR, ILLINOIS
July 19, 1956

The meeting was called to order at 11:30 A.M., after a coffee hour for old and prospective members, in the Colonial, by Mrs. H. W. Gibson, Pres., presiding. Present were: Mrs. Leigh, Unger, Cresswell, Smith, Hurley, Cohn, Griffin, Gibson, and Woyna.

The use of balloons to remind people of the Blue Ballot was discussed. It was suggested they were too expensive as well as impractical since balloons do not last long. Mrs. Leigh suggested they be used in displays in selected spots around town instead of being used as giveaways. Mrs. Leigh moved, seconded by Mrs. Hurley, that we order 100 balloons. Motion carried.

There is about \$150 from Action in Community which can be allocated elsewhere. Mrs. Smith said the Adult Activities group is to put out a brochure which will cost approximately \$50 a page. Mrs. Hurley moved, seconded by Mrs. Leigh, that we go to the expense of 1/2 page, if it is within \$25, plus our share of postage. Motion carried.

Mrs. Gibson said there would be some expenses for Revenue. Mrs. Cohn moved, seconded by Mrs. Hurley, that a maximum of \$20 be set aside for miscellaneous Revenue expense. Motion carried.

Meeting adjourned at 12:00 Noon.
