

MINUTES OF BOARD MEETING
LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS, DECATUR, ILLINOIS
June 14, 1956

It was moved by Mrs. McCracken, seconded by Mrs. Griffin, that Helen Leigh be appointed publications chairman.
